- Wed* 1 ♦ **Holy Martyrs and Wonder-workers Cosmas and Damian, the unmercenary healers of Asia Minor, and their mother St. Theodota.** St. David of Euboea
- Thu* 2 Great-Martyrs Akindynos, Pegasios, Aphthonios, Elpidophoros, and Anempodistos of Persia
- Fri* 3 Martyrs Askepsimas Bishop, Joseph Priest, and Aethalas Deacon of Persia. St. George the new-martyr of Neapolis (†1797). St. Lydia
- Sat* 4 Holy Ascetic Father Ioannikios the Great of Olympus(†842). Hieromartyrs Nikandros, Bishop of Myra and Hermeus the Presbyter. St. Porphyrios the mimic (†361)
- Sun* 5 Great-Martyrs Galaktion and his bride Episteme. Apostles Hermas, Patrobas, Linos 2nd Bishop of Rome, Gaius, Philologos of the 70. St. Jonas, Archbishop of Novgorod
- Mon* 6 St. Paul I the Confessor, Patriarch of Constantinople (†361). Righteous Luke
- Tue* 7 The 33 martyrs of Melitene. Lazarus the wonder-worker, the Stylite of Mt. Galesius (†1054)
- Wed* 8 ♦ **Synaxis of the Chief Commanders Michael, Gabriel, and Raphael, and of all the Bodiless Powers [rest from labor].** Holocuast of Crete (1866). St. Simeon the translator
- Thu* 9 St. Nectarios, Metropolitan of Pentapolis: Wonder-worker and ascetic Father of Aegina (†1920). Martyrs Onesiphorous & Porphyrios. Holy Ascetic Mothers Matriona & Theoktiste.
- Fri* 10 Apostles Erastus, Olympas, Rodion, Sosipatros, Quartus, Tertius of the 70. Martyr Orestes
- Sat* 11 Great-martyr Menas (Egypt), Martyrs Victor (Italy), Vincent the Deacon (Spain) and Stephanie. Our Holy Father Theodore the Studite (†826)
- Sun* 12 **Our Father among the Saints John the Merciful, Patriarch of Alexandria.** St. Martin of Tours, France. St. Nilus of Sinai the myrrh-streaming. New-martyr Savvas (†1726)
- Mon* 13 **Our Father among the Sts John Chrysostom, Abp. Constantinople(†407) [rest from labor]** New-martyr Damaskinos of Cp (†1681). Blessed Irene Myrtidiotissa (†1960)
- Tue* 14 **Holy Apostle Philip of the 12 [rest from labor].** St. Gregory Palamas, Wonder-worker Archbishop of Thessalonike. New-martyrs Constantine of Hydra; Panteleimon of Spetsae

- Wed* 15 Martyrs of Edessa: Gourias, Shamuna, Habib the Deacon. Thomas, Patriarch of CP. St. Paisius (Velichkovsky †1843). St. Felix of Nola. Emperor Justinian and Theodora
- Thu* 16 ➔ **Holy Apostle and Evangelist Matthew**
- Fri* 17 Our Father among the Saints Gregory the Wonder-worker, Bishop of Neocaesaria. St. Gennadios, Patriarch of Constantinople. St. Nikon the disciple of St. Sergius of Radonezh
- Sat* 18 ➔ Great-martyr Platon and Martyr Romanus. St. Anastasius the New-martyr (†1750)
- Sun* 19 ➔ Holy Prophet Abdias (Obadiah). Holy Martyr Barlaam
- Mon* 20 ➔ Pre-festival of the Entry of the Theotokos into the Temple. Our father among the Saints, St. Gregory of Dekapolis; Proklos, Archbishop of Constantinople. St. Dasios martyr (†299)
- Tue* 21 ➔ **Entry of our Most-Holy Lady Theotokos and Ever-Virgin Mary into the Temple [rest]**
- Wed* 22 Holy Apostles Philemon, Apfia, Archippus, and Onesimus of the 70 Holy Martyr Mother Cecelia, and Valerian, Tiburtios. St. Michael, Great prince of Tver
- Thu* 23 ➔ Our Fathers among the Saints St. Amphilochios, Bishop of Iconium, friend of St. Basil the Great; and Gregory, Bishop of Agrigentum, Sicily. St. Alexander Nevsky
- Fri* 24 Our Fathers among the Saints and Hieromartyrs Clement, 3rd Bishop of Rome and Peter, Bishop of Alexandria (†311). St. Mercurius of the Kievan Caves
- Sat* 25 ➔ **Holy and all-wise Great Martyr Ekaterina (†311) [rest from labor]** Apodosis of the Entry of the Theotokos. Great-martyr Merkurios
- Sun* 26 ➔ St. Stylianos, the hermit of Paphlagonia. St. Alypius the Stylite (†608).
- Mon* 27 ➔ Holy Iakovos, Great-martyr of Persia. Righteous Nathaniel. "Kursk" Icon of the Theotokos
- Tue* 28 ➔ Holy ascetic martyr Steven the New, confessor (†766). St. Irenarchus the martyr
- Wed* 29 Paramonos of Balsatia and the 370 martyrs with him (†255). Dionysios, Bishop of Corinth. Martyrs Philoumenos, Valerinus, and Phaidrus
- Thu* 30 ➔ **Holy, glorious, and all-lauded Apostle Andrew, the First-Called. [rest from labor]** St. Alexander, Bishop of Methymna. Frumentios of Ethiopia

Fasting key: Plain font Mon xx = no fasting. *Bold Font Mon xx*= fast day: no meat, eggs, dairy products, fish, oil or wine {alcohol}.
